

Storage Advancement

It has been a busy few years for **ICA** and sister company **STS Refrigeration**. There has been significant investment in modern CA store facilities, which have been part funded by **SEEDA** and other bodies across the UK. With the latest uncertainties concerning future funding, Andrew Wills, MD of ICA, sees the outlook for the next 12 months to be a

little subdued. "2011 will see fewer CA stores built in the UK; however, there will still be plenty of activity in the storage sector."

ICA have recently been awarded the contract to build 12 new CA stores for **Boxford (Suffolk) Farms Ltd**. STS Refrigeration will be installing a secondary refrigeration system using Hycool, which will pro-

vide Boxford with the most efficient system available. The complex will be controlled by the ICA6000, which is **David Bishop's** latest automated control system, manufactured in Paddock Wood at ICA's head office.

Exports remain a large part of the Instrument Division's sales at ICA and currently control systems are being manufac-

tured for orders in India, the USA, Azerbaijan, Australia, South America, Norway and many Western European countries.

So far in January, ICA have been awarded other CA store contracts in Wisbech, Herefordshire and Kent.

ICA carry out a large number of smaller, on-farm projects, which are a critical part of the
